The Principal welcomed all the PTA members present and asked the Secretary to read aloud the minutes of previous PTA meeting. After the reading, all attendees approved the minutes of the previous meeting.

The principal discussed that the new academic session would begin on 1st April 2026, similar to the current academic structure.

The examination schedule for the academic year was also discussed in detail. It was proposed that the first set of examinations would begin around 9th July (shifted to the second week of July as requested by some parents). Another examination period is planned for September, with tentative dates from 16th September to 24th September. Adjustments were made after considering feedback from parents and teachers, particularly in relation to festival celebrations during that period. As a result, it was agreed that there would be no examinations on 17th and 18th September, allowing students to participate in religious and cultural observances without academic pressure. Examinations would resume afterward and continue until completion of the scheduled papers.

In other matters it was decided that school would ask student to celebrate their birthdays in school in ways that did not involve distribution of sweets, which was agreed by all keeping the sugar awareness program in mind.

Since matters were discussed as per Agenda, the meeting was called to an end.
