The meeting started at the decided time. The Secretary read out the agenda of the meeting as well as the minutes of the previous meeting. The principal congratulated all the attendees for the successful event of Founders' Day. The principal also discussed about various upcoming activities like Annual Day, Sports Day and other events where other institutions would also be involved as a hub. The other events would take place as scheduled in the school calendar.

Principal explained the query of a parent about selecting the students for an event, that the students are selected based on their performance. Selection is done and the best student is selected out of the participants. Also the selection is also subject to the rotation of 3 years, so that all the deserving participants should get equal opportunity.

Principal also urged that proper sanitary habits should be inculcated among students which also included their personal hygiene as well as etiquettes while using the sanitary fixtures properly to avoid damage to the school property.

During the meeting the matters about students' behaviour were brought to attention. Principal showed a great concern about disciplinary issues among children and appealed the parents for their cooperation and suggestions for the improvement. Mr. Garg and Mrs. Nanawati along with other parents agreed that parents need to take care and observe the behaviour of their wards at home also and communicate with them at regular intervals guiding them wherever they are wrong. Open communication would be best to make the children understand about being well mannered. The other suggestions were having workshops/ lectures with students where more parents' involvement should be there.

Counselling at regular intervals for specific students will help students to a greater extent. The counsellors informed that counselling sessions were already in progress with selected students regularly and positive results were seen among children.

Parents also suggested to have a report of the students showing their emotional progress at regular intervals to be communicated to parents so that proper efforts could be taken for their improvement.
