Ms Rathi suggested that some parents felt that school timings should be reduced to which the Principal said that the timings were an important part of the school functioning.

Mrs Rathi also suggested that the prep should be monitored to which the principal said that the same was being done and invited the PTA members to visit and observe the school during prep.

Dr Maniyar said that parents do not get enough time to meet the teachers during the PTM meetings. Principal suggested that if everyone followed the time stipulated things would be better and we all should make an effort for the same. Though if there was any critical issue to be discussed the parents could always ask for an appointment.

Mr Mante suggested that 100% children should get above 75% achievement. To which the principal replied that all efforts are being made towards the same. He also wanted the teachers to train the students for different competitive examinations. To this the Principal replied that it is difficult but with the introduction of worksheets things could be further looked into.

Principal also suggested that the teachers have a lot of work on hand and work really hard and that if we have the cooperation of parents and if we take a joint responsibility towards our children greater things could be achieved.
