The Principal welcomed all PTA members and asked the secretary to read aloud the minutes of Executive selection procedure dated August 23.

After the reading all attendees approved the minutes of the previous meeting.

The Principal presented the new fee structure with an increase of 10% and sought approval from the members present. All members approved the hike in fees unanimously.

Ms. Abha Khandelwal raised a query about warm clothes and inners. Ms. Khandelwal also raised the issue of reference books. The Principal replied that we provide reference books to teachers and these books can be used by students and we already follow this practice. Ms. Khandelwal suggested for the use of old hand down books. The Principal explained such practice is not possible due to periodic changes in the textbook content by NCERT.

Mr. Aditya Borade requested to reduce the school time by reducing the sports period. The Principal replied the sports hour is our unique identity and also a mandate by CBSE.

Ms. Neeta Dhembre requested to stop swimming class for the winter.

The Principal explained that we need to make students more resilient.

Ms. Khandelwal suggested that the elder students should be given charge of looking after the younger one's as this will make them more responsible and develop a bond among them.

School counselor Ms Jyoti Dhakne explained that we have already started peer education system.

Ms. Archana Jakkalwar added that we have implemented the same in the primary classes also.

The issue of reshuffling of classes. The Principal replied that we are facing numerous issues because of reshuffling. Majority of member were in favour of reshuffling in primary section and were against the idea of reshuffling for the secondary section.

The Principal informed that as per NEP guidelines we intend to provide more courses apart from commerce for grade 11 and 12.

Ms. Neeta Dhembre raised the issue of falling standards of discipline and manners.

The Principal agreed and expressed her concern and requested all members to stand firm and collaborate with all like minded people to face the challenge. It was also requested that PTMs must be held regularly to which the Principal explained that we do conduct PTMs every month end only in the month of October due to Diwali Vacation we couldn't conduct it.

Ms. Neeru Agrawal raised the issue of sports shorts to which the Principal assured that she would immediately talk to the uniform makers to make knee length shorts.
