The Principal welcomed all PTA members and asked the secretary to read aloud the minutes of November 22, 2024.

After the reading all attendees approved the minutes of the previous meeting.

The Principal informed the attendees that the school is Planning to make certain changes for the next academic year things may not roll out immediately but are planned for the next academic year

1. Separate blocks for classes 6 to 8 and 9 to 12.
2. Conducting separate Annual Day and Sports Day
3. Classes 6 to 8 will have sports in the morning session while classes 9 to 12 in the afternoon session

The reason behind these changes was the increase in the strength of students.

The Principal informed the attendees that school is not going to tolerate indiscipline and indecent behaviour of students school will issue notices to such students and after the third notice the student will have to leave school.

The Principal invited parents to check the food offered at breakfast and lunch.

The Senior Secondary Coordinator requested parents to send their wards regularly to school. Specially parents of students belonging to classes 10 and 12 must be more vigilant about this issue. The Principal asked the attendees if they have any queries

Ms. Abha Khandelwal raised a query about class 8 Annual Examination time table as Mathematics paper was scheduled the very next day of Holi

However, after a careful consideration it was decided that there would be no change in the time table.

Ms. Snehal Deshpande asked whether there would be any change in school time for summer the Principal explained that there would be no change in school timing it very premature to predict anything but we consider the issue as and when situation arises.

A query was raised regarding provision of notebooks before exams to which the Principal said that question papers are not set according to note book they are more of competency based so students don't need note books.

The Principal highlighted the importance of good parenting.
Ms. Snehal Deshpande thanked the Pre-Primary teachers for their exemplary work.

As the agenda was discussed and further no other matter had to be discussed the Principal proposed the Vote of Thanks. As it was the last PTA meeting of the academic year, she thanked all PTA members for their cooperation and urged that they should continue with their cooperation. The principal requested the PTA members to remain active in matters pertaining to school and that they can contact authorities though they will not be PTA members, she thanked them for all their support and concluded the meeting.
